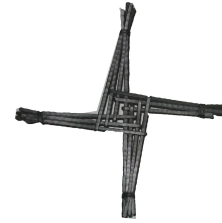


- Any administrative matters should be referred to Jonathan Lord (946 5045) in the first instance.
